

Sixth Grade Camp FAQs

When do I need to show up on Tuesday morning?

All campers should report to Bursley on Tuesday, November 3rd, by the first bell at 8:45 a.m. However, if it is possible, those who have medications to check in with our nurse should arrive by 8:30 a.m. Upon arrival, campers should bring their luggage to the designated area (indoors if raining, or by the "Pick-Up Zone").

Do I need a sack lunch for Tuesday?

Yes! All students are required to bring a sack lunch.

We will be eating our sack lunches at camp before we begin our afternoon activities. Please don't forget a beverage and be sure to include only containers that can be thrown away when you are done eating!

Do I go to Band, Orchestra, or Accelerated Math on Tuesday morning?

No. Also, if you attend a math group that is not with a sixth grade teacher, you should make arrangements to get the assignments and homework you will miss before you leave for camp. That is your responsibility.

What should we do with my medications?

Our camp nurse will be at Bursley on Tuesday morning.

PLEASE leave all medications in their original containers and label the containers with the camper's name and dosage instructions!

Also, please place all medications together in a Ziploc bag and ensure that a camp medication permission form has been completed for EACH medication you are bringing to camp.

(Our nurse will have extra medication forms on hand Tuesday morning, in the event that something has changed since you turned in your original forms.)

What time should an adult pick me up on Friday, November 6th?

The busses usually arrive at Bursley around 12:30 p.m. Mrs. Steele will keep in touch with parents via email on Friday morning to confirm our anticipated arrival time. Once we get to school, you may immediately claim your luggage (and your medication from our nurse!) and head home with the adult who is picking you up!

Once you get home, plan on taking a nap to catch up on some sleep! 😊
